We have just under $\$ 8 \mathrm{~K}$ in the account that has not been allocated towards anything in particular. Shannon proposed some ideas:

- Set aside the full amount that it would cost to replace the popcorn machine
- Bump up the reserve amount in the savings account from the current $\$ 500$ to $\$ 3,500$
- Purchase our CheddarUp Card reader for $\$ 70$ after taxes
- Bump the Running Club budget from $\$ 1,000$ to $\$ 1,300$
- Potential for a PTO Website (Approximately $\$ 200$ per year)
- Donation to Bond \$510
- Gift the "hot cocoa day" to the students as opposed to charging for it
